



CAPITOL WEST ACADEMY ATHLETIC POLICY

Students at Capitol West Academy are expected to maintain a passing grade in each subject while participating in sports. Teachers will notify the Coordinator of Student Services, who will notify the coaches and parents when academic effort is not sufficient for participation in a sport. Work will be monitored on a weekly basis to determine eligibility for the following Monday through Saturday. Children who are absent from school because of illness may NOT appear for practice or games.

I understand that participating in sports through school is a privilege. I understand that, as a representative of CWA and its athletic program, I must be a role model to others. I agree to uphold the following values in school, at practice, and throughout the community:

- RESPECT: I will show respect to peers, teachers, competition and coaches.
- RESPONSIBILITY: I will take responsibility for my performance.
- HONESTY: I will be honest with myself and others.
- ACHIEVEMENT: I will work tirelessly to improve in all aspects of my life.

RULES

- Late assignment of more than 2 days – student will attend practice but sit out and complete late homework.
- Two or more tardies – student will sit out the first 20 minutes of practice.
- Detention for disrespect/defiance/disruption – student will sit out one quarter of one game.
- In-school suspension – student will attend but be ineligible to play in one game.
- Out-of-school suspension or major infraction of the school code of conduct during school or practice – student will forfeit eligibility for practice and participation in a game for one week from the day of the infraction. Continued violation of the school code of conduct will result in forfeiture for the remainder of the season.

Academic probation: Students may not participate in any after-school or extracurricular activities, including basketball, cheerleading, soccer, book club, dances pride night, etc., as well as school programs and recess. In order to be released from probation, students must complete daily assignments on time, in a quality manner, for two weeks straight.

Note: repeated infractions could result in dismissal from the team.

At the beginning of every practice, I will show my passport to a coach. If there are any late assignments, tardies, detentions or in-school suspensions, the teacher will note it in the passport and the coach will issue the agreed-upon consequence. The coach will then sign the parent/teacher comment section of the passport.
